1. Make sure you have a good quality camera.

- For smartphones, the back camera is the best, but newer smartphones have a decent front camera.
- If you have an external webcam, ensure it's at least 720p.
 - If none of these methods of recording work for you, your computer's webcam should be a last resort.
- 2. If you have a microphone, make sure to use it; if not, no worries!

3. Frame yourself on camera.

- Check how you look before recording. Set up a spot where you can sit in good lighting.
- The background should not be too busy/messy, and you should be centered in the frame. We should be able to see from your stomach/chest up, and on the screen, your head should have a few inches of room on top.

Once you are ready to film, please answer the following questions:

Where were you when you first learned of the October 7th attacks and what was your reaction?

- How did your campus react to the news?
- How has October 7th impacted you?
